#### NATIONAL AND INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL

- 1. Is it still compulsory to show the Green Pass to arrive in Sardinia from another Italian region?

  No. Following the expiry of DECREE-LAW No. 24 of March 24<sup>th</sup> 2022, from May 1<sup>st</sup> 2022 access to air transport services nationally will be permitted without a Green Pass.
- 2. I am fully vaccinated/not vaccinated, to arrive in Italy from an EU/Extra UE country do I have to make a test before departure?

No, from June 1<sup>st</sup> 2022, the Green Pass or other equivalent certification is no longer required for entry or re-entry into Italy.

Restrictive measures for arrivals from abroad due to COVID-19 are no longer in force.

### 3. Is it possible to travel from abroad to Italy?

Yes. Restrictive measures for arrivals from abroad due to COVID-19 are no longer in force.

### 4. What documents are required to arrive in Italy from an EU/Extra EU country?

From June 1<sup>st</sup> 2022, the Green Pass or other equivalent certification is no longer required for entry or re-entry into Italy. Restrictive measures for arrivals from abroad due to COVID-19 are no longer in force. Therefore, it will not be necessary to show any certification upon boarding.

# 6. What type of mask must I wear on board the aircraft in order to travel?

According to the new Law of the Ministry of Health of June 15<sup>th</sup> 2022, the mask on aircraft is recommended, but not mandatory.

However, it is mandatory to use FFP2 masks on the public transport such as ships, ferries, trains, buses and vehicles used in local or regional public transport services.

The aforementioned Law is valid until September 30<sup>th</sup> 2022.
